Containers will come with a liner, and rain cover to be secured during transport/storage. Once containers are loaded and the waste is characterized, US Ecology will profile the waste and provide shipping documentation for transportation of the waste to a TSDF. US Ecology will arrange transportation and disposal from Skagway to TSDF for two containers of non-hazardous lead contaminated soil, and two containers of RCRA lead contaminated soil.

Assumptions:

- This quotation for services is for immediate acceptance and is subject to change by US Ecology Alaska without notice. Estimates are valid for 30 days from the date of quotation.
- 1 Cubic yard is estimated to weigh ~1.5 tons.
- Net weight of HAZARDOUS waste containers is limited to 22 tons. Overweight containers will be subject to additional fees.
- Non-hazardous disposal fee covers the first 25 tons of material. Additional tons will be charged \$70 per ton, for each ton over 25 tons.
- Rain covers must be secured during storage and transportation.
- US Ecology Alaska will bill actual Time and Materials based on listed contracted rates.
- Requested materials, rented equipment, and third-party charges will be invoiced at cost plus 20%.
- Billing starts and finishes portal to portal for all equipment.
- All generated materials will be packaged for transportation and disposal per 49 CFR and 40 CFR guidelines.
- If delays are encountered outside the control of US Ecology Alaska, the client will be billed "Stand-by time" at the current rates.
- If the Scope of Work identified above changes, US Ecology Alaska's assigned Project Manager will "stop" the project, contact the client's POC (Point of Contact), and help develop a cost-effective plan to complete the scope of work.

- The disposal method is determined by analyses provided by the Customer and must be pre-approved by the disposal facility prior to shipment. Additional charges will apply if the waste is found to be outside of the pre-approved profile determination.
- Prior scheduling is required to complete the scope of work, or additional charges will apply.
- Materials disposal is pending Generator characterization.
- Disposal pricing is based on the disposal method. The price estimate may vary from the final price, which is based on the final TSDf profile approval and waste receipt.
- The standard work week is Monday through Friday, 8 am to 5 pm. Any hours worked outside of the standard work week or on observed holidays will be billed at overtime rates.
- The weather in Alaska can be challenging and unpredictable. US Ecology Alaska will be prepared to work in wet or cold conditions as long as the project's objectives can be achieved safely and in compliance with all required federal, state, and local regulations.

US Ecology Alaska is providing a good faith estimate for the charges and fees that may be incurred within the scope of work, but the actual costs may vary from or exceed the estimate.



1. **This signed estimate must be received as an official Notice to Proceed for any project or change order.**
2. US Ecology Alaska's Energy, Security, Insurance, and Compliance fee of 24% is based upon the total invoice, excluding taxes, state and local fees. This line item replaces any previous fee for fuel surcharges or other non-service-related fees.
3. Customer acknowledges this quote is a good faith estimate of the charges and fees that may be incurred within the scope of work, but the actual charges and fees may vary from or exceed the estimate. Customer agrees to pay the actual charges and fees.
4. The Customer agrees to pay in full and on time all charges and fees within the scope of work, and within any authorized change order. Payment terms are net 30 unless other arrangements have been made prior to the start of work.
5. Customer agrees to pay all applicable tax or permit fees.
6. US Ecology Alaska reserves the right to require security and take other steps to ensure Customer timely and fully pays all charges and fees. US Ecology Alaska may suspend services if Customer fails to make full and timely payment.
7. Invoices paid by credit card will incur a 3% processing fee.
8. US Ecology Alaska has no obligation to perform any services or incur any costs unless and until this Estimate and Work Order is authorized and signed by Customer and returned to US Ecology Alaska. US Ecology Alaska has no obligation to perform any services or incur any costs beyond those described within the scope of work in this Estimate and Work Order unless and until a written change order is executed and signed by both Customer and by US Ecology Alaska.

11. Expedited services (less than 24-hour notice) are considered emergency response and will incur a 10% invoice surcharge. Expedited services may not be available for all work projects.
12. If applicable, disposal pricing is based on generator's status and disposal method. The price above may vary from the final price, which is based on final TSDf profile approval and waste receipt.
13. If applicable, based on the scope of work, Customer will package all material in DOT-approved shipping containers in accordance with Department of Transportation regulations. Any containers not meeting such regulatory standards will be repackaged at the Customer's expense.
14.
