RESOLUTION NO. 10-21R

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA COMMITTING MATCHING FUNDS FOR A UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TIGER II GRANT TO ASSIST IN FINANCING THE SKAGWAY PORT GATEWAY PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Assembly of the Municipality of Skagway passed and approved Resolution No. 10-14R on June 17, 2010, which resolution authorized the Borough Administration to submit a TIGER II grant application to assist financing the Skagway Port Gateway Project; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly understands that the proposed Gateway Project is estimated to cost approximately \$25.4 million; and

WHEREAS, TIGER II grant regulations do not require applicants for projects located in rural areas, like Skagway, to provide matching funds; and

WHEREAS, TIGER II grant regulations allow Federal grant reviewers to consider whether applicants for projects located in rural areas provide matching funds when evaluating TIGER II grant requests; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly therefore desires to provide matching funds to assist financing the Gateway Project; and


WHEREAS, TIGER II grant regulations call for applicants, other than applicants for projects in rural areas, to support 20 percent of the costs of the project with funds other than federal funds;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Municipality of Skagway will support 20 percent of the costs of the Gateway Project with funds other than federal funds, including any solicited local match from its partners; White Pass & Yukon Route, AIDEA, and the Yukon Government.
