MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA RESOLUTION NO. 10-24R

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA SUPPORTING THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADE AND AUTHORIZING ADMINISTRATION TO SUBMIT A SPECIAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT PROJECT (SAAP) GRANT APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) TO SECURE FUNDING.

WHEREAS, The impact of more than 800,000 visitors each year severely strains the capability of the current wastewater treatment infrastructure found within the community; and

WHEREAS, The community wishes to address concerns the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has with the current wastewater treatment facility; and

WHEREAS, The Municipality of Skagway wishes to pursue retrofit of its treatment facility with installation of membrane bioreactor system that will solve issues of regulatory compliance going well into the future; and


WHEREAS, The Municipality of Skagway has been allocated \$300,000 of SAAP grant funding for its wastewater treatment plant upgrade project through Special Appropriations Act Project (SAAP) grants authorized by the EPA's FY 2010 Appropriations Act.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Municipality of Skagway supports the Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade and authorizes administration to submit a Special Appropriations Act Project grant application to the EPA to secure funding.
