**A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA SUPPORTING A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF HYDRO-ELECTRICITY IN WEST CREEK AND AUTHORIZING ADMINISTRATION TO SUBMIT A RENEWABLE ENERGY FUND GRANT APPLICATION TO THE ALASKA ENERGY AUTHORITY (AEA) TO SECURE FUNDING.**

**WHEREAS,** The Municipality of Skagway wishes to address concerns regarding the cost of power within the Skagway Borough; and

**WHEREAS,** The Municipality of Skagway wishes to pursue a feasibility study to determine if hydro-electricity can be generated from West Creek; and

**WHEREAS,** The Municipality of Skagway has approved \$59,000 in its FY 2011 budget to serve as the required match for the Renewable Energy Fund Grant.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Municipality of Skagway supports a feasibility study for the development of hydro-electricity in West Creek and authorizes administration to submit a Renewable Energy Fund grant application to the AEA to secure funding.
