A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN MUNICIPAL PROPERTY AS THE LOCATION FOR A RAIN GARDEN.


WHEREAS, the Municipality of Skagway owns Lots 10, 11 and 12, Block 73, where the future Senior Center will be located; and

WHEREAS, Taiya Inlet Watershed Council (fiscally sponsored by the Southeast Alaska Watershed Coalition) has received a grant from the Alaska Dept. of Environmental Conservation to develop a rain garden on a portion of Block 73, Lots 11 and 12, to be maintained by the Taiya Inlet Watershed Council / Southeast Alaska Watershed Coalition for a period of at least five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of January 16, 2014, the Skagway Borough Assembly voted unanimously to approve Taiya Inlet Watershed Council's plan for development of a rain garden on the property; and
