

MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA RESOLUTION NO. 15-22R

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SKAGWAY, ALASKA AMENDING COMMERCIAL USE AND NON-COMMERCIAL USE FEES FOR THE SKAGWAY SMALL BOAT HARBOR, REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 11-10R, AND APPROVING THE BOAT MAINTENANCE BUILDING RENTAL AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, It is necessary to adjust the Non-Commercial Use Fees at the Small Boat Harbor to account for use of the new Boat Maintenance building at the Small Boat Harbor; and

WHEREAS, A boat maintenance building rental agreement is required to assign responsibility for use of the facility and establish rules for use of the facility, and to assure that the Municipality is held harmless and indemnified;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Assembly of the Municipality of Skagway that the following fee schedule for the Skagway Small Boat Harbor is hereby adopted:

Commercial Use Fees:

Commercial Use of Harbor All commercial vessels, including but not limited to fishing charters and kayaks, shall pay the following rates per revenue passenger as a tariff for loading and unloading passengers at the Skagway Small Boat Harbor:

- \$ 1.50 from April 1, 2012 through March 31, 2013; and
- \$ 1.60 from April 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014; and
- \$ 1.70 from April 1, 2014 through March 31, 2015; and
- \$ 1.80 from April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016.

If the vessel only loads passengers at the Harbor, or only unloads passengers at the Harbor, the fee shall be as follows per passenger:

- \$ 0.75 from April 1, 2012 through March 31, 2013; and
- \$ 0.80 from April 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014; and
- \$ 0.85 from April 1, 2014 through March 31, 2015; and
- \$ 0.90 from April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016.

Barge Fees for Ferry Float \$0.50 per foot per day or \$5.00 per foot per month (barge and tug length) for all barges loading or unloading at the Ferry Float unless otherwise covered in a Municipal staging area or tidelands lease.

Commercial Launch Ramp \$ 20.00 daily
\$ 300.00 annual

Cruise Vessel Docking Fee at Ferry Float \$200

Non-Commercial Use Fees:

Annual Moorage \$ 13.25 from April 1, 2012 through March 31, 2013;
\$ 13.50 from April 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014; and
\$ 13.75 from April 1, 2014 through March 31, 2015; and
\$ 14.00 from April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016;

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
Transient Moorage	includes boat launch ramp fee \$ 0.37 per ft/day and \$3.70 per ft. per month from April 1, 2012 through March 31, 2014; and \$ 0.40 per ft/day and \$4.00 per ft. per month from April 1, 2014 through March 31, 2016
Long-term Storage	\$ 0.20/sq. ft. per month
Kayak Storage	\$ 7.00 per month per vessel
Live a Board	Single Family Residential Utility Rate
Pressure Washer	\$ 20.00/hr.
Grid Fee	\$ 15.00 per tide
Haul-out Fee	\$ 200.00/rt.
Boat Launch Ramp Fee	\$ 10.00 per launch-includes all boats, kayaks, canoes, etc.; or \$ 50.00 per year per boat
Waiting List Fee	\$ 50.00 initial fee to get on list \$ 10.00 annual fee (This will not be renewed automatically. Bills will not be sent. It will be the responsibility of the individual to contact the harbormaster if they wish to remain on the list, and pay the fee. Failure to do so will result in removal from the waiting list)
Harbor Crane Use Fee	\$ 20.00 per hour with a ½ hour minimum; or \$50.00 annual fee
<u>Boat Maintenance Building:</u>	
	<u>Bay Rental 4/1-9/30 \$ 30.00 per day.</u>
	<u>Bay Rental 10/1-3/31 \$ 45.00 per day.</u>
	<u>Cleaning Deposit \$ 500.00 per rental period.</u>
Transient Electrical Rates	\$ 10.00 per day for 30 amp; and \$ 20.00 per day for 50 amp.
Transient Billing Surcharge	\$ 10.00 surcharge will be added to any transient fee not paid prior to departure of the transient vessel.
Senior Citizen Discount	15% will apply to annual moorage fees paid by residents of Skagway who are age 65 or older for personal pleasure craft.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 11-10R is hereby repealed and replaced by this resolution; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Skagway Small Boat Harbor building rental agreement, attached as Exhibit A, is hereby adopted for use.

EFFECTIVE DATE: the resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
