

Jánwu Sít'i (Mountain Goat Glacier) AKA Denver Glacier Trail Access

Per your request, I've compiled some notes about Jánwu Sít'i (Mountain Goat Glacier) aka Denver Glacier Trail.

The Skagway Visitor Department sees a need for infrastructure development that will help disperse people and alleviate congestion. Providing pedestrian access to Denver Glacier Trailhead is one great option to help us achieve this. It increases access to that area year-round when trains are not running. And increases hiker safety by eliminating the temptation to walk on the railroad right-of-way.

I've initiated conversation with the US Forest Service to discuss the possibilities.

- I contacted Pete J. Schneider, Recreation Program Manager for the US Forest Service on December 21st. (Assemblyperson Kolodi is copied on the e-mail). He said they are transitioning to a new district ranger, Michael Downs, and a new Deputy District Ranger, Laura Buchheit. I think it would be great to try and schedule a meeting with their team to see what it will take to start this project given it is subject to NEPA requirements.
